Premises and Garden Developments

Objective:

• Ensure that the environment remains a beautiful space that inspires and contributes to the large majority of children making excellent progress

Health and Safety

Objective:

• Ensure that the School and Centre has an effective Health and Safety Policy and that all staff are clear about their roles and responsibility in this area.

Induction, Supervision and Ongoing Mentoring and Coaching

Objectives:

- Ensure staff are supported to understand the ethos and the practice in the Nursery School, Special Support Centre and Orchard Room throughout their first year.
- Ensure that all other staff are supported to be reflective practitioners of the highest quality through ongoing mentoring and coaching.

Inclusion

Objectives:

- Ensure that all SEND and EYPP documentation is current and available on school website.
- Further develop the use of Person Centred Planning (PCP) including graphic facilitation with guidance from the E.P.
- Establish training needs for all staff in line with 30 hours uptake. Promote the use of Makaton and visual aids across the nursery school and day care provision.
- Further develop the use of multicultural resources and involve families in supporting this through ongoing building of trusting relationships, support and information sharing.
- Complete aspects of the Accessibility Audit as a staged process.

Objective:

• Continue to foster a collective responsibility for the outcomes for young children in our locality and beyond.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Objective:

• To further enhance children's progress, particularly those with EAL, CP and CIN, in the Managing Feelings and Behaviour and Making Relationships strands of PSE.

Communication, Language and Literacy

Objective:

• Create enhanced opportunities to support the strands of *speaking* and *understanding* in Communication and Language and the Literacy strand of *reading*.

Objective:
